Built strong for reliability

Though light in weight, the National N-80 is designed for tough materials-handling jobs. Extratough, high-strength, low-alloy steel gives it an exceptionally high strength-to-weight ratio.

Special counterbalance valves hold the lift, fold and extend cylinders in place in the event of hose failure, and serve as overload relief valves to slowly lower the load in the event of an overload condition.

Cylinder shafts are hard chrome-plated. Highpressure tubing is used wherever possible to reduce hose wear.

Where possible, the heavy-duty wire-braided hydraulic hoses are routed inside structural members for protection from bumps, twists, cuts and abrasions. National's special three-point mounting system absorbs loading flex, protecting the truck frame from excessive stress.

Heavy-duty hydraulics

All N-80 couplings and fittings are of high quality. All hydraulic hoses, tubes and fittings have a 4:1 minimum safety factor on burst. All cylinders are double acting for smooth, positive control.

High-capacity, heavyduty pumps are standard. An efficient, high-pressure vane pump produces full system pressure even at truck engine idle speed and maintains high efficiency throughout its life. A two-bolt mounting flange can be integrally mounted to most PTOs to simplify mounting.

A specially-designed oil tank, with an oil level sight gauge, breather, magnetic plug and 10-micron external return line filter integrally mounted to the crane frame, reduces mounting time and space requirements. The oil tank is detachable for fast, easy maintenance.

Wide outriggers provide stability

Standard, wide-span outriggers constructed from high-strength, low-alloy steel form a lightweight, stable base that can be set up quickly from either side of the truck. N-80 outriggers extend to 14' (4.3 m) horizontally and


25.5" (65.8 cm) vertically. Both horizontal and vertical extensions are powered hydraulically.

The wide outrigger span allows for lower truck chassis weight requirements and more payload capability—up to 13,200 pounds (6 MT)—on a minimum single-axle truck. Large 8" x 14" (20.3 cm x 35.6 cm) outrigger footpads help provide solid stability in soft or uneven ground conditions.

Outrigger vertical legs lock in place up or down by pilot-operated check valves. The vertical cylinders lock automatically when stowed, so they will not leak down in transit. The legs are removable for shipment and storage.




Rack-and-pinion rotation

The N-80 gives you the smoothness, precision and control of rack-and-pinion rotation. National's rack-and-pinion system is simple, reliable and—because it has few parts—easy to maintain and service. Rack-and-pinion rotation also reduces the bulk of the crane frame above the truck, lowering the center of gravity for greater stability.

Easy operation


The N-80 is equipped with dual waist-level controls with identical operation of normal crane functions. The operator can work the controls from either side of the crane while keeping the boom and load in full view at all times. The control knobs, illustrated with function symbols, operate the smooth, fine-metering, five-spool control valves with pinpoint accuracy. The boom can be worked and rotated simultaneously. You won't find a crane easier to operate. Additional valve banks for operating hydraulic accessories can be easily added.



N-80 (Model 32M38) lift and reach capabilities

The N-80 is a "hook point" machine. Capacities shown on the capacity charts are maximum loads at specific hook points rather than at specific load radii or combinations of boom angles and boom lengths.

A load can be lifted on a National articulating crane if the load is within the capacity of the hook point and its arc about the inner boom position. If the load is within the capacity of the hook point being used to lift the load, it can be positioned anywhere the

hook arc permits by at least one crane function. All crane functions may not be able to move the load to all positions within the arc unless the position of the boom is at its best mechanical advantage. Note: Always refer to the capacity chart (located near the operator's station) to determine what hook point will be used to lift the load. Never exceed the capacity of the hook point.

Mounting

It is essential that the truck used for mounting this crane meet the minimum requirements (shown below and at right) for capacity loads.

Minimum Truck Specifications

180° Working Area This vehicle will permit lifting capacity loads in all areas around the rear of the vehicle in a 180° arc from outrigger to outrigger. No load should be lifted over the front of the vehicle unless extra stabilizing provisions are made, such as the addition of front stabilizers and/or extra weight in the

truck bed.

360° Working Area This vehicle will permit lifting capacity loads in all areas around the vehicle in a 360° arc. Caution should be employed when rotating from the rear to the front as the vehicle springs will compress and cause a change in the level of the vehicle. Always rotate loads slowly and smoothly to maximize control.

Rear Mount

The advantages of a rearmount are: (1) the location of the crane allows the operator to effectively use the close-in working area to lift heavier capacity loads, and (2) it permits lifting capacity loads in a 360° arc. Caution should be employed when rotating from the rear to the front as the vehicle springs will compress and cause a change in the level of the vehicle. Always rotate loads slowly and smoothly to maximize control



Note:

Weights of all accessories attached to the boom or loadline of the crane must be deducted from the effective lifting capacity.

Consult your dealer for specific accessory availability. Some accessories cannot be used in combination with other accessories and/or certain boom/jib combinations.



Remote Control

National offers a one-hand remote control for all crane models. Ideal for use where precise control and total load visibility are required, a remote control is a lightweight, easy-to-use way to add to your crane's versatility.

Fine metering and instant response mean operators can position loads or work platforms easily. A priority control valve, operated by a trigger on the remote control unit, regulates oil flow and provides fingertip speed control over all crane functions.

National's remote controls feature solid state circuitry and few working parts. They are designed for reliability.

Available in three models: Model MR4 controls the lift, turn, fold and extend functions. Model MR5 is the same as MR4, but accommodates an accessory. Model MR6 is the same as MR4, but adds two accessories.




